ABOUT MYACTIVE LEEK



MyActive Leek sits within the beautiful green space of Brough Park, in the heart of the Staffordshire Moorlands. Designed not just as a leisure centre, but as a welcoming anchor for the whole community; a place that supports people to move more, feel better and live healthier lives day to day.

The transformation of MyActive Leek, led by Staffordshire Moorlands District Council, is one of the most ambitious projects in our journey towards modern, inclusive active wellbeing service. The £17 million project has been funded by £10.8m from the UK Government, £3m from the Council, £1.8m from Sport England and over £1.1m from Salix for decarbonisation measures.

When it opens in Summer 2026, MyActive Leek will offer a thoughtfully designed indoor and outdoor spaces which encourage movement, fun, prevention, rehabilitation, community connection and friendship. The facility will include:

- 25m main pool and separate teaching pool
- Extended fitness suite and group exercise studios
- Adventure soft play with party area
- Active wellbeing suite to support new to exercise or health-based referral programmes
- Spaces that enable family activity, inclusive programming and partnerships with local health, education and community organisations
- A centre layout that puts accessibility, comfort and member experience at the heart of every visit

The Swimming Teacher role involves planning, delivering, and assessing a programme of engaging, safe, and inclusive swimming lessons.

Key responsibilities include:

- Meeting individual learning needs in line with an agreed syllabus
- Applying a range of effective teaching methods to support learner development
- Delivering clear instruction both in and out of the water, including practical demonstrations
- Teaching water safety skills and ensuring all learners are supervised in accordance with Safe Supervision Guidelines

In addition, Swimming Teachers are responsible for carrying out ongoing assessments and adapting lessons to support continuous improvement. The role also includes supporting the delivery of booster lessons throughout the year as part of the MyActive Learn to Swim Programme.
